* 11 ball of Scheepjes Catona Antique Mauve 257

Needle: to get rid of your threads at the end
Scissors: to cut threads

## $1^{\text {st }}$ square bottom right

Row 1: In a magic ring " $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 7,1 \mathrm{sc}$," repeat 7 more times what's stands between"" pull the ring tight so it closes nicely. (see picture 1)

Row 2: 2 sl st around the edge of the first loop (so you can crochet 1 sc on top), 1 sc on top of that loop (see picture 2), "ch 3, 1 sc on top of next loop" repeat 6 more times what's stands between """, ch 3 and close the round with a sl st.

Row 3: 1 sc in the ch-sp between the loops, ch 2 (continues for 1 dc see picture 4), 6 dc in the same ch-sp, "in the next ch-sp, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$, ch 3 , in the following ch-sp 7 dc ", repeat 2 more times what's stands between""", ch 3,1 sc, ch 3 in last ch-sp and close round with sl st. (picture 5 is row 3 ).


Row 4: on the 7 double crochet from the previous round proceed as follows: ch 3 (this continues for 1 dc ), 2 dc , then $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 3-1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet in one stich, 3 dc , "ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chsp , ch 2, on the next 7 dc from previous round work as follows: 3 dc , then 1 dc-ch 3-1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet in one stich, 3 dc , repeat 2 more times what's stands between """, ch 2,1 sc in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in next ch-sp, ch 2 , close the round with a sl st. (see picture 6)

Row 5: ch 5, "in the corner 1 sc-ch $5-1$ sc, ch 5,1 sc in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch 2 ,
1 sc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5", repeat 2 more times what's stands between "", in the corner 1 sc-ch 5-1 sc, ch 5,1 sc in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch 2 , close the round with a sl st in the first stich you started this round with, fo.(see picture 7)

## $2^{\text {nd }}$ square bottom left

Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ square, bottom right.
Row 5: ch 5, 1 sc in the corner, ch 2, (now we are going to crochet the square to the $1^{\text {st }}$ square, the bottom right) take your hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the ch-sp of the corner from the $1^{\text {st }}$ square, the bottom right (see picture 8) and pick up the loop again and pull it under that ch-sp, ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square you are working on (the square, the bottom left), ch 2 , crochet hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook
under the ch-sp of 5 chains of the square, bottom right and pick up the loop again and pull it under that ch-sp, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ of the square bottom left (the square you are working on) (see picture 9), ch 1, hook out of the loop, hook under the next ch-sp of 2 chains from the square, bottom right and pick up the loop again, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp of the square, bottom left (the square you are working on), ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop, hook under the next ch-sp from the square, bottom right and pick up the loop again, ch 1,1 sc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp of the square, bottom left (the square you are working on), ch 2 , crochet hook out of the loop, hook under the 5 chains of the square bottom right and pick up the loop again, ch 3, 1 sc in the corner of the square bottom left (the square you are working on), ch 2 , hook out of the loop and go with your hook under the ch-sp of the corner from the square, bottom right and pick up the loop again, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the corner of the square bottom left (the square you are working on) (the square, bottom left is now attached to the square, bottom right, see picture 10 ), ch $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, 1 sc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5 , in the corner you crochet $1 \mathrm{sc}-\mathrm{ch} 5-1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5 , in the corner 1 sc-ch 5 $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch 2 close round witha sl st in the stitch you started this round with, fo. (picture 11, the 2 bottom squares together)

## Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ square, bottom right.

Row 5: ch 5, 1 sc in the corner, ch 2, (now we are going to crochet the square to the bottom left square) hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the ch-sp of the corner of the square bottom left and pick up the loop again and pull it under the ch-sp, ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square top left (the square you are working on see picture 12), ch 2, hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the ch-sp of 5 chains of the square bottom left and pick up the loop again and pull it under that ch-sp, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ of the square top left (the square you are working on see picture 13), ch 1 , crochet hook out of the loop, crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp of 2 chains from the square bottom left and pick up the loop again and pull it under that ch-sp, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp of the square top left (the square you are working on), ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop go with your crochet hook under the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp of the square bottom left and pick up the loop again, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp of the square top left (the square where you are working on), ch 2, crochet hook out of the loop and go with your hook under the ch-sp of 5 chains of the square bottom left and pick up the loop again and pull it under that ch$\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the corner of the square top left (the square you are working on see picture 14), ch 2 hook out of the loop, crochet hook under the ch-sp of the corner of the square bottom left and pick up the loop again, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the corner of the square top left (the square you are working on see picture 15), ch $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5 , in the corner $1 \mathrm{sc}-\mathrm{ch} 5-1 \mathrm{sc}$, ch $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5 , in the corner $1 \mathrm{sc}-\mathrm{ch} 5-1 \mathrm{sc}$, ch $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch 2 , close the round with a sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch you started this round with, fo.(see picture 16).

## $4^{\text {th }}$ square top right

## Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ square, bottom right.

Row 5: ch 5, 1 sc in the corner, ch 2 , (we will now work the last square on the other 3 squares)crochet hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the ch-sp of the corner of the square top left, pick up the loop again and pull it under the ch-sp, ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square top right (the square you are working on, see picture 17 A and $B$ ), ch 2 , crochet hook out of the loop, crochet hook under the ch-sp of 5 chain of the square top left and pick up the loop again and pull the loop under the ch-sp, ch 3,1 sc in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}$ sp of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop, crochet hook under the ch-sp of 2 chain of the square top left and pick up the loop again and pull it under the ch-sp, ch 1,1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ of the square top right (the square you're working on), ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop, crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ of 2 chain from the square top left and pick up the loop and pull it under the ch-sp, ch 1,1 sc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 2 , crochet hook out of the loop and under the ch-sp of 5 chain of the square top left and pick up the loop and pull it under that ch-sp, ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square top right (the square you are working on, see picture 18), ch 1, (we are now going to work the corner at the corner of the square top left and the corner of the square bottom right), crochet hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the ch-sp of the corner from the square top left (see picture 19) and pick up the loop again, ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop and under the ch-sp of the corner from the square bottom right and pick up the loop again, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the corner of the square top right (the square you are working on, see picture 20), ch 2, crochet hook out of the loop and under the ch-sp of 5 chain
of the square bottom right and pick up the loop again and pull it under, ch 3, 1 $s c$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$ of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 1 , crochet hook out of the loop and under the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp of 2 chain of the square bottom right and pick up the loop again and pull it under, ch 1,1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 1, crochet hook out of the loop and under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp of the 2 chain and pick up the loop again, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 2 , hook out of the loop and under the ch-sp of 5 chain of the square bottom right and pick up the loop again and pull it under, ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch 2 , hook out of the loop and under the ch-sp of the corner of the square bottom right and pick up the loop again (see picture 21), ch 3,1 sc in the corner of the square top right (the square you are working on), ch $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, ch 5 , in the corner 1 sc-ch 5-1 sc, ch 5,1 sc in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp, ch 2,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch-sp, ch 2 , close round with sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch you started this round with, (do not cut the wire!!).

## Crochet border

Row 1: in the chain of 5 chains you crochet 4 sc (see picture 23), in the chain where you joined the squares together you crochet 2 sc each side (see picture 24), in the small chain of 2 chains you crochet 2 sc (see picture 25), in the corners you crochet 5 sc (see picture 26), in this way you work all the way around with singel crochets, close the round with a sl st, fo. (picture 27 squares with a border of singel crochets)


Row 2: put on color Antique Mauve, you start in the middle of the corner in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ stitch with 1 sc (it is the $\mathbf{3}^{\text {rd }} \mathbf{~ s c}$, see picture 28), this round you also crochet a border with sc, in each stich a sc, in each corner (it is the $3^{\text {rd }}$ stich of the corner, see picture 29)1 sc-ch 2-1 sc, finish the round in the corner where you started, 1 sc , ch 2 and close the round with a sl st, fo (see picture 30)


Row 3: put on the color you crocheted the squares with, this round you also crochet a border with singel crochets, exactly the same as row 2 , you start in the corner with 1 sc , in each stich a sc, in each corner $1 \mathrm{sc}-\mathrm{ch} 2-1 \mathrm{sc}$, finish the round in the corner where you started, $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 2$ and close the round with a sl st, fo.
Row 4: put on color Antique Mauve, this round you also crochet a border with singel crochets, exactly the same as row 2 , you start in the corner with a 1 sc , in each stich a sc, in each corner
$1 \mathrm{sc}-\mathrm{ch} 2-1 \mathrm{sc}$, finish the round in the corner where you started, 1 sc , ch 2 and close the round with a sl st, fo.

You crochet 42 pieces of these patches and place them in the order you want to crochet them together.

## Crocheting the patches together.

Put the wire on at the $1^{\text {st }}$ patch in the corner whit a slip knot (color 385 Chrystalline) and crochet chain 2 (goes on for a dc), then take the patch you want to crochet to it (color 252 Watermelon) and put the hook in the corner at the backsite of your work and crochet a double crochet in the corner (see picture 33)

"ch 1, you skip a stitch and start crocheting a double crochet but do not finish it, like this: yarn over, through the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the double crochet (because you skip a stitch) of the $1^{\text {st }}$ patch (of color 385 Chrystalline) pick up the yarn and pull it through the stitch, yarn over and crochet the first two loops (2 loops on the hook, see picture 34).

You also do this in the other patch (color 252 Watermelon), like this: skip 1 stitch, yarn over, put in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the double crochet (because you skip a stitch), pick up the yarn and pull it through the stitch (4 loops on the hook) and crochets the first two loops (3 loops on hook), yarn over and crochets the remaining 3 loops, see picture 35)"

keep repeating what is between "" until you reach the end of the $1^{\text {st }}$ patches in the corners (see picture 36).


When you have crocheted the first two patches together (see picture 37),

(picture 37)
ch 1 , and you pick up the next 2 patches to crochet them on patches what you already crochet togheter (see picture 38),

(picture 38)
proceed exactly as you did with the first two patches. You start in the patch (color 519 Fresia) in the corner with a double crochet but do not finish it, like this: yarn over, hook trough the corner, pick in the right side of the patch (color 519 Fresia) pick up the yarn and pull it through the corner, yarn over and crochet the first two loops (2 loops on the hook, see picture 39).

You do the same in the other patch (color 408 Old Rose), like this: yarn over, you put the crochet hook in the corner at the backsite of the patch and pick up the yarn again and pull it through the corner (4 loops on the hook) yarn over and crochet the first two loops (3 loops on the hook), yarn over and crochet the remaining 3 loops (see picture 40),

Keep repeating what is in the first section between """ but with the other colors. Repeat all this again and again until you have 2 rows of 7 blocks crocheted together (see picture 41).

And this is how you crochet the patches together, patch by patch and lane by lane in the same direction lengthwise (see picture 42)

You do this exactly as you crocheted them together lengthwise. You start in the corner of the $1^{\text {st }}$ patch and crochet a chain 2 (this goes on for a double crochet) then you take the patch next to it and put the crochet hook in the corner at the backsite and crochet a double crochet (see picture 43)

"ch 1, you skip a stitch and start crocheting a double crochet but do not finish it, like this: yarn over, through the $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the double crochet (because you skip a stitch) of the $1^{\text {st }}$ patch pick up the yarn and pull it through the stitch, yarn over and crochet the first two loops (2 loops on the hook, see picture 44).

You also do this in the other patch, like this: skip 1 stitch, yarn over, put in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch from the double crochet (because you skip a stitch), pick up the yarn and pull it through the stitch (4 loops on the hook) and crochets the first two loops (3 loops on hook), yarn over and crochets the remaining 3 loops, see picture 45)"

Keep repeating what is between "" until you reach the end of the $1^{\text {st }}$ patches at the intersection (see picture 46).

When you reach the intersection, go with your hook under the bow of ch 1 (see picture 47) and make a single crochet.

proceed exactly as you did with the first two patches. You start in the $1^{\text {st }}$ patch in the corner with a double crochet but do not finish it, like this: yarn over, crochet hook trough the corner, pick in the right side of the patch pick up the yarn and pull it through the corner, yarn over and crochet the first two loops (2 loops on the hook, see picture 48).

You do the same in the other patch, like this: yarn over, you put the crochet hook in the corner at the backsite of the patch and pick up the yarn again and pull it through the corner (4 loops on the hook) yarn over and crochet the first
two loops (3 loops on the hook), yarn over and crochet the remaining 3 loops (see picture 49).

Keep repeating what is in the first section between "" Repeat all this patch by patch and row by row until you have completely crocheted all 42 patches together (see picture 50).

## the border

Row 1: You crochet all the way around the blanket, in every stitch a single crochet, you start in a corner with 1 sc (see picture 51),


In each stitch you work a single crochet, in the part where you worked the patches together you crochet 2 sc on one side, 1 sc in the middle and 2 sc on the other side (see picture 52),

(picture 52)
and so you go all the way around, in the corners you crochet 1 sc , ch 2,1 sc (see picture 53).

You end this row in the corner where you started with a single crochet.
At the end you crochet in this corner 1 sc, ch 2, you close the round with a slip stitch (see picture 54).

Row 2: ch 3, skip a stitch, 1 hdc, "ch 1, skip a stitch, 1 hdc," repeat what is between """ to the first corner.

In the corners crochet 1 hdc ch 2,1 hdc (see picture 55),

this is how you crochet all the way around the blanket and you close the round in the corner with 1 hdc, ch 2, and close the round with a sl st. (see pictures 56)

Row 3: In the first ch-sp 1 sc, ch 1 (continues for a hdc, see picture 57), 1 hdc, in the in the following chain spaces crochet 2 hdc (see picture 58), in corners crochet 2 hdc, ch 3, 2 hdc (see picture 59), close the round with a sl st.


Row 4: ch 3, skip a stitch, 1 hdc (just between the 4 half double crochets, above the half double crochet from row 2 (see picture 60), "ch 1, skip a stitch, 1 hdc" repeat what is between "" In the corners crochet 1 hdc, ch 2, 1 hdc (see picture 61), this is how you crochet all the way around the blanket, you end this row with a ch 1 and close the round with a sl st.

Row 5: in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp} 1 \mathrm{sc}$, ch 1 (continues for a hdc, see picture 62), 1 hdc, in the following ch-spaces crochet 2 hdc in each ch-sp (see picture 63), in corners crochet 2 hdc , ch 3,2 hdc (see picture 64), close the round with a sl st.


Row 6: ch 3, skip a stitch, 1 hdc (just between the 4 half double crochets, above the half double crochet from row 4 (see picture 65), "ch 1, skip a stitch, 1 hdc" repeat what is between "" In the corners crochet 1 hdc, ch 2, 1 hdc (see picture 66), this is how you crochet all the way around the blanket, you end this row with a sl st.

Row 7: in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch-sp 1 sc , ch 1 (continues for a hdc, see picture 67), 1 hdc, in the following ch-spaces crochet 2 hdc in each ch-sp (see picture 68), in corners crochet 2 hdc, ch 3,2 hdc (see picture 69), close the round with a sl st.


Row 8: in this round we only crocheting single crochets, we start in the corner with a ch 2 (continues for 1 single crochet) 1 sc , ch 3,2 sc (see picture 70), then all sc in each stitch 1 and in the corners crochet 2 sc , ch $3,2 \mathrm{sc}$, you end this row with a sl st.
At the end of this row you have 323 stitches in length and 281 stitches in width. If you do not get to this amount of stitches you have to decrease or increase to get the amount of stitches you need for row 9.

Row 9: in the next stich 1 sc , ch 2 (this continues for a double crochet, right between the $\mathbf{2}$ sc in the corner of the previous round, see picture 71),
(You now crochet in the width of the blanket) in the corner you crochet 1 dc- ch $3-1$ dc, in next stitch 1 dc, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, " 2 sc, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, 1 dc- ch 2-1 dc in 1 stitch (see picture 72), ch 2, skip 2 stitches" repeat what's between "" 38 times, 2 sc , ch 2, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc , and in the corner $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 3-1 \mathrm{dc}$,
(you are now crochet in the length of the blanket) in next stitch 1 dc , ch 2, skip 2 stitches, " 2 sc, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, 1 dc- ch $2-1$ dc in 1 stitch, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches" repeat what's between "" 44 times, 2 sc , ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, 1 dc , and in the corner you crochet $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 3-1 \mathrm{dc}$.
(Width) in next stitch 1 dc , ch 2, skip 2 stitches, " 2 sc , ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 2-1 \mathrm{dc}$ in 1 stitch, ch 2, skip 2 stitches " repeat what's between "" 38 times, 2 sc, ch 2 skip 2 stitches, 1 dc , in the corner crochet 1 dc -ch $3-1 \mathrm{dc}$. Row 10: \{between the 2 double crochets from the previous round just before the corner you crochet 1 sc , ch 2 (this continues for a double crochet, see picture 73), in the corner $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 1-1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 1-1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 1-1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 1-1 \mathrm{dc}$ between the 2 double crochets from the previous row crochet 1 dc (see picture 74), ch 1\},

Row 11: \{between the 2 double crochets of the previous round you start with a single crochet (see picture 76), in the corner you crochet on the bow of 5 double crochets between the double crochets as follows: 1 sc (between $1^{\text {st }}$ double crochet and $2^{\text {nd }}$ double crochet from previous round in the corner), 1 sc-ch 4-1 sc in the same chain space (this is between $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ double crochet from previous round in the corner), ch 4,1 sc-ch $4-1$ sc in the same chain space(this is between the $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet from the previous round) 1 sc (this is between the $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round in the corner) 1 sc , between the $5^{\text {th }}$ double crochet and last double crochet $\}$, " 1 sc in the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain space, 1 sc in the next chain space, in the bow of 5 double crochet, crochet as follows: 1 sc (between the $1^{\text {st }}$ double crochet and $2^{\text {nd }}$ double crochet) 1 sc-ch $4-1$ sc in same chain space (this is between $2^{\text {nd }}$ and $3^{\text {rd }}$ double crochet), ch 4,1 sc-ch $4-1$ sc in same chain space (this is between $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet), 1 sc (this is between the $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ double crochet)" (see picture 77).
