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Some of the stitches, I used my own crochet abbreviations. At the Abbreviations U.S. terms you can read what the abbreviations mean. And in the the pattern itself also the explanation of how to crochet these stitches.

Materials:

- Yarn, Scheepjes cotton 8: 2 bolls red (nr.510), 2 bolls whit (nr.502), 1 ball green (nr.713), 1 ball pink (nr. 719) en 1 ball fuchsia (nr. 720).
- 2 D rings 30 mm (3 cm) stainless steel
- Swivel snap hooks 38 mm
- Crochet hook D/3 (3 mm)
- Scissors
- Needle
- Stitch markers
- Strengthening for the bottom of cardboard or plastic of 8.7 x 15.2 inches (22 x 6 cm)
- Fabric for the lining: the size and amount of fabric you need, you see in the further description of the chapter "Lining of the bag"
- sewing machine

Abbreviations U.S. terms

ch:	chain
tc:	turning chain
hdc:	half double crochet
sc:	single crochet
dc.fl	double crochet front loop (the loop in front of your work)
dc.b:	double crochet at the back
dc.ba:	double crochet behind and around
sc.bl:	single crochet in the back loop
sl-st:	slip stitch
fo:	fasten off
yo:	yarn over

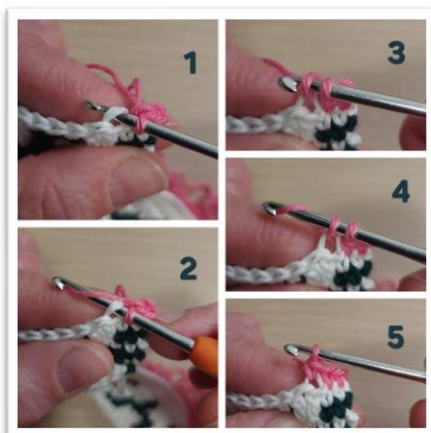

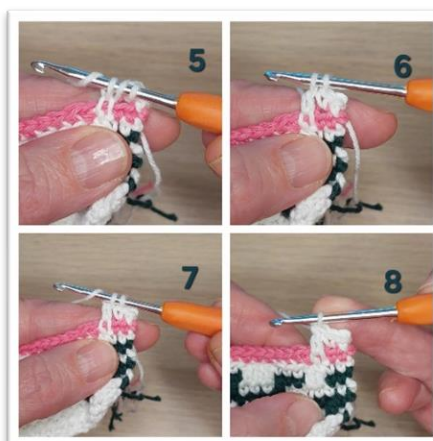
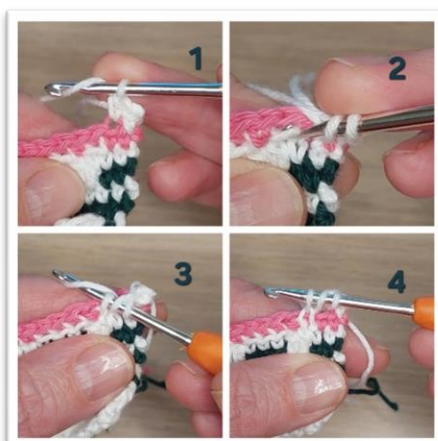
special stitches

single crochet in the back loop (abbreviation = sc.bl)



- 1) crochet hook through the back loop of the stitch
- 2) take the thread and pull it through the loop
- 3) 2 loops on your hook
- 4) yo and crochet the 2 remaining loops on your hook
- 5) you have crocheted a single crochet in the back loop (sc.bl)

double crochet front loop (the loop in front of your work) (abbreviation = dc.fl)



- 1) yo
- 2) insert your hook through the loop at the front of your work
- 3) yo and pull it through the loop
- 4) 3 loops on your hook
- 5) yo and crochet the first two loops
- 6) 2 loops on your hook
- 7) yo and crochet the 2 remaining loops on your hook
- 8) you have crocheted a double crochet front loop (dc.fl)

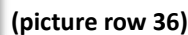

Envelope border

We are now going to crochet a border around the patch with sl-st and we will only do this on the sides and bottom of the patch. **(do not crochet too tightly, see picture 1, picture 2 front and back)**

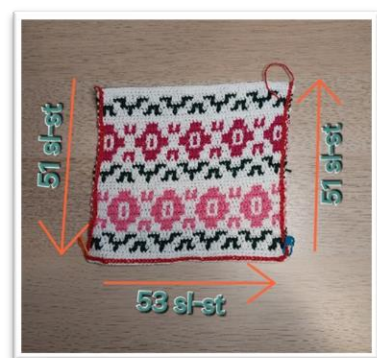
Row 1: 51 sl-st on the sides of the patch and 53 sl-st on the bottom **(see picture 3)** Notice!! do not crochet too tightly, fo.

(**1st corner, see picture 18**), 6 sc, “1 dc.fl, 1 sc, 1 dc.fl, 5 sc, 1 dc.fl, 5 sc”, repeat what is between “” 12 more times, 1 dc.fl, 1 sc, 1 dc.fl, 6 sc, 3 sc in 1 stitch (**2nd corner, see picture 19**), (**the side**) 11 sc, 3 sc in 1 stitch (**3rd corner, see picture 20**), 6 sc, “1 sc around the double crochet (see picture 21), 1 sc, 1 sc around the double crochet, 5 sc, 1 sc around the double crochet, 5 sc”, repeat what is between “” 12 more times, 1 sc around the double crochet, 1 sc, 1 sc around the double crochet, 6 sc, 3 sc in 1 stitch (**this is the 4th corner**), 11 sc, end the row with a sl-st in the 1st stitch, weave in the loose ends.

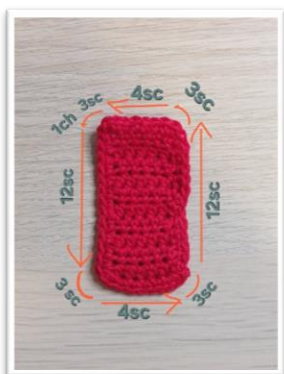

Lining of the bag

How much fabric do you need?

You are now going to cut the fabric to size before we start putting the bag together.

Fabric:

- bag parts, 2 patches of fabric from 9.5 x 10.2 inches (24 x 26 cm) (see picture 23 and 24),
- intermediate piece, patch of fabric from 3.2 x 29.2 inches (8 x 74 cm) (see picture 25)
- patches for the D rings for the shoulder strap, 2 patch of fabric from 3.9 x 2.8 inches (10 x 7 cm) (see picture 26)

Cut the piece of fabric to size by pinning the crocheted parts to a piece of fabric and mark this 0.39 inch (1 cm) around the crocheted part with a fabric chalk or pencil. And cut out the parts 1 by 1 in this way. **(measuring that 0.39 inch (1 cm) extra space around the fabric, you need dat space to sew the parts together, see picture 23 and 24 for the bag parts and picture 25 and 27 for the intermediate part).** To measure the length of the intermediate piece of the bag, add together the sides of 9.5 inches (24 cm) and the bottom of 10.2 inches (26 cm), which gives you a length of 29.2 inches (74 cm) (see picture 27)

I did not add lining to the shoulder strap, simply because I did not like it. But if you want to sew lining into the shoulder strap, measure the fabric for this strap exactly as you did with the bag parts.

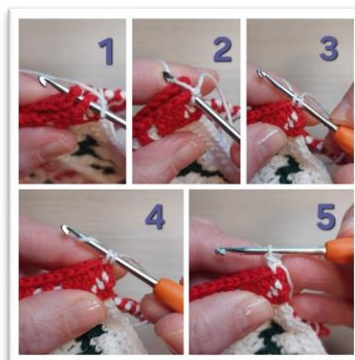

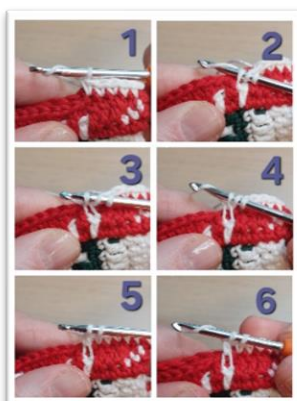

- 11) 3 loops on your hook.
- 12) yo and crochet the remaining 3 loops in one go.
- 13) 1 loop on your hook, you have now crocheted a dc.fl/dc.b
- 14) picture of the dc.b
- 15) what your dc.fl/dc.b looks like when your work is lying flat.

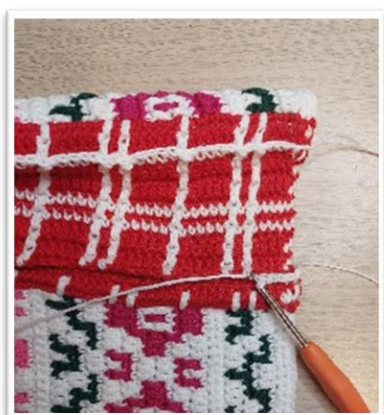

I started in the red part of the bag with a sl-st about 0.39 inch (1 cm) or so from the edge **(see picture 43)**. **Little tip** crochet loosely because you have to pick up the stitches again. 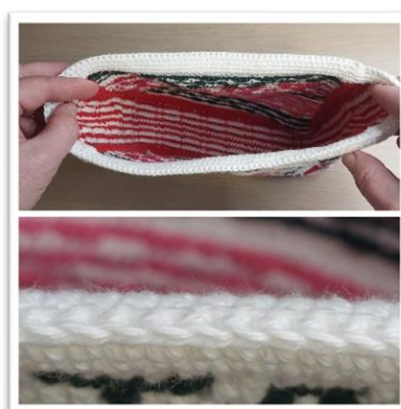

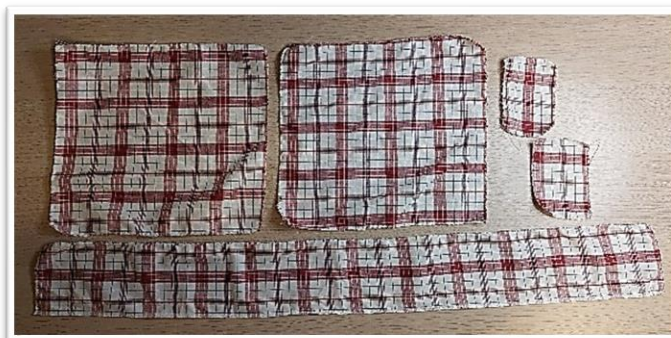
Sewing lining into bag

On my You Tube channel [Akhaakwerkjes-free crochet patterns](#) In a tutorial from Ming tāsje/My Bag in part 7 I will show you how to sew the lining into the bag.

We are going to stitch all the parts along the edge with a zigzag stitch on the sewing machine, This prevents the fabric from fraying. (see picture 54 and 55)

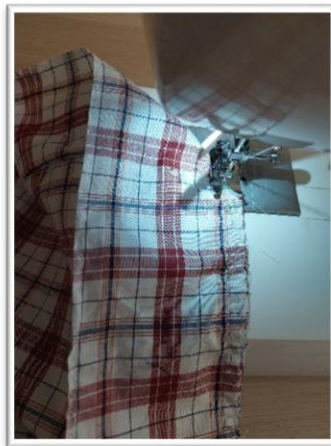

Now sew the parts together ± 0.39 inch (1 cm) along the edge. Pay attention at the corners to pull the fabric straight so that you do not accidentally double stitch it. **(see picture 61 and 62)**

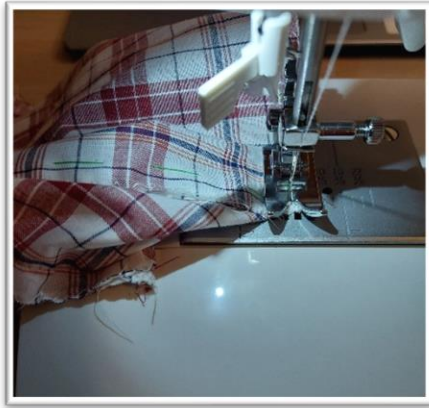

After pinning, lace this section as well, and sew it together ± 0.39 inch (1 cm) along the edge. Be careful at the corners to pull the fabric straight so you don't accidentally double-stitch it **(see picture 66 and 67)**. After sewing this part, now also remove the lace thread. And now you have sewn a nice little pocket that fits inside the bag. **(see picture 68 and 69)**

We will now sew the loops for the D rings into the bag. You fold them in half lengthwise and pin them in place **(see picture 77)**, you do this with both patches for the loops **(see picture 78)**.

Lace up the part you pinned and sew it in place with the sewing machine **(see picture 79)**, then turn the loops inside out so that the stitching edge is on the inside **(see picture 80)**.

Then you pull the loops through the D rings and pin them **(see picture 83)**, stitch these in place under the sewing machine about 0.39 inch (1 cm) from the end of the loops **(see picture 84)**, and along this stitching edge you sew the loops into the bag, you pin the loops in the middle of the intermediate section and you let the stitching edge run parallel to the stitching edge of the bag **(see picture 85)**.

And when you have sewn the loops, click the shoulder strap onto the D rings, the strengthening of the bottom you can cover it with the fabric you used for the lining. Your bag is ready!!! have fun with it.
