Materials:

- Yarn: 33 balls Katia Canada
- Crochet hooks: 15 mm, 12 mm, 9 mm
- Needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers

dc:	double crochet
cl:	cluster
sc:	single crochet
sl-st:	slip stitch
tc:	turning chain
hdcp:	half double crochet in pairs
yo:	yarn over

fo:	fasten off

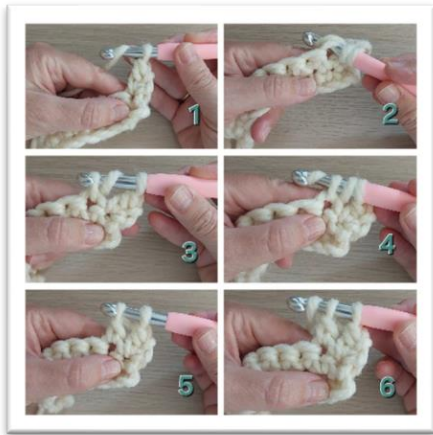

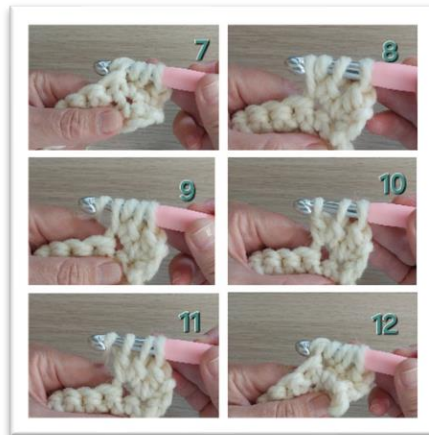

Special stitches:

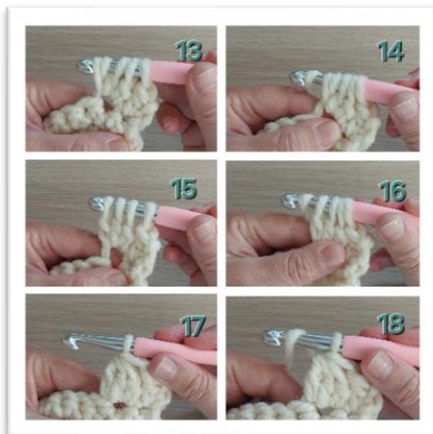
Cluster(c1): yo, put the hook into the stitch, pick up the yarn (3 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook through the same stitch and pick up the yarn (4 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (3 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (5 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (4 loops on your hook), crochet the remaining loops in one go, ch 1. **(see picture 1,2,3 and 4)**



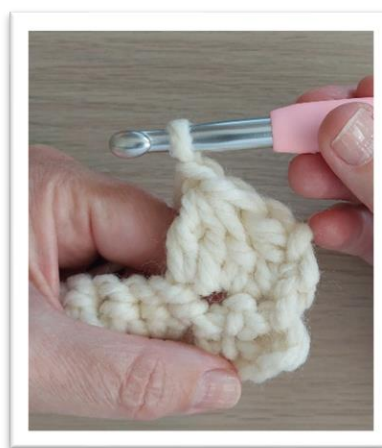

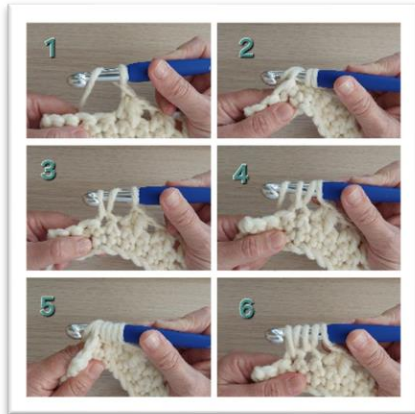

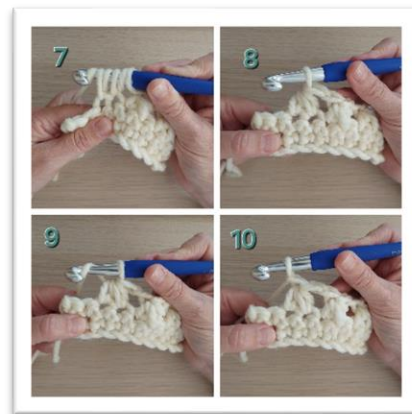
- 1) yo,
- 2) put the hook into the stitch,yo, and pull it through the stitch,
- 3) 3 loops on your hook,
- 4) yo, crochet the first 2 loops,
- 5) 2 loops on your hook,
- 6) yo,
- 7) put your hook through the same stitch, yo, and pull it through the stitch,
- 8) 4 loops on your hook,
- 9) yo, crochet the first 2 loops,
- 10) 3 loops on your hook,
- 11) yo,
- 12) put your hook through the same stitch, yo, and pull it through the stitch,
- 13) 5 loops on your hook,
- 14) yo, crochet the first 2 loops,

- 15) 4 loops on your hook,
- 16) yo, crochet the 4 remaining loops in 1 go,
- 17) 1 loop on your hook,
- 18) ch 1 (picture 4, you have crocheted a cluster)

hdcp: (crochet this stitch loosely) Yo, put the hook into the stitch, pick up the yarn and pull it through the stitch (3 loops on your hook). Yo, put the hook into the next stitch, yo, and pull it through the stitch (5 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining 5 loops in one go, ch 1. You have crocheted a half double crochet in pairs. **(see picture 5 and 6)**

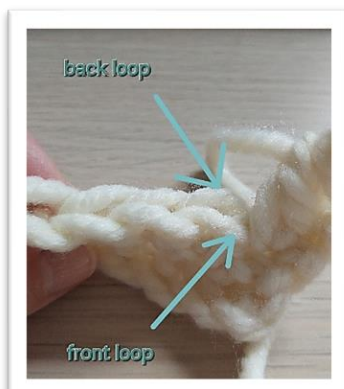
- 1) yo,
- 2) put the hook into the stitch, yo, and pull it through the stitch
- 3) 3 loops on your hook,
- 4) yo,
- 5) put into the next stitch, yo, and pull it through the stitch,
- 6) 5 loops on your hook,
- 7) yo, crochet the remaining 5 loops in one go,
- 8) 1 loop on your hook,
- 9) ch 1,
- 10) you have crocheted a hdcp.

Blanket Sanne:

Row 1: (15 mm crochet hook) ch 106, tc (= 107 stitches)

Row 2: (12 mm crochet hook) 106 sc, tc.

Row 3: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc. (see picture 7a and 7b)

Row 4: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 5: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 6: 1 dc, 52 hdc in the back loop to the second to last stitch, 1 dc in the last stitch tc.

Row 11: 2 dc, skip 1 stitch, "1 sc, skip 2 stitches", repeat what is between "" 32 times, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 12: 2 dc, skip 1 stitch, "1 sc (is on the single crochet of the previous round), skip 2 stitches", repeat what is between "" 32 times, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 13: 2 dc, skip 1 stitch, "1 sc (is on the single crochet of the previous round), skip 2 stitches", repeat what is between "" 32 times, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 14: 2 dc, skip 1 stitch, "1 sc (is on the single crochet of the previous round), skip 2 stitches", repeat what is between "" 32 times, 1 sc, skip 1 stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 28: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “2 dc in the back loop in 1 stitch, 2 dc in the back loop in 1 stitch, skip 2 stitches”, repeat what is between “” 24 times, 2 dc in the back loop in 1 stitch, 2 dc in the back loop in 1 stitch, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc, tc.

Row 29: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “2 dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in 1 stitch, skip 2 stitches”, repeat what is between “” 24 times, 2 dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in 1 stitch, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc, tc.

Row 30: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “2 dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in 1 stitch, skip 2 stitches”, repeat what is between “” 24 times, 2 dc in 1 stitch, 2 dc in 1 stitch, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc, tc.

Row 52: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 53: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 54: (9 mm crochet hook) 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl in the back loop, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what is between “” 50 times, 1 cl in the back loop, 1 dc, tc.

Row 55: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what is between “” 50 times, 1 cl, 1 dc, tc.

Row 56: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what is between “” 50 times, 1 cl, 1 dc, tc.

Row 57: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what is between “” 50 times, 1 cl, 1 dc, tc.

Row 58: 1 dc, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what is between “” 50 times, 1 cl, 1 dc, tc.

Row 62: (12 mm crochet hook) 106 sc, tc.

Repeat row 3 till row 62 again!!

Row 63: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 64: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 65: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 66: 1 dc, 52 hdc in the back loop to the second to last stitch, 1 dc in the last stitch, tc.

Row 67: 106 sc, tc.

Row 68: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 69: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc, tc.

Row 70: 1 sc, 104 sc in the back loop, 1 sc.

Do not cut the wire, we will continue with the border of the blanket!!!

The blanket border:

Row 1: ch 2, 1 sc in the same stitch where you just ended (this is in the corner if necessary, use a stitch maker so that you can easily find the corners), 154 sc (in total this is 155 sc in the length of the blanket), ch 2, 1 sc in the same stitch where you just ended (this is the 2nd corner), 105 sc, ch 2, 1 sc in the same stitch where you just ended (this is the 3rd corner), 154 sc, ch 2, 1 sc in the same stitch where you just ended (this is the 4th corner), 105 sc, end this

row with a sl-st in the first stitch, tc and turn your work.

Row 2: 1 sc in the back loop (=106 sc in the back loop), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=155 sc in the back loop), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=106 sc in the back loop), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=155 sc in the back loop), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), end this row with a sl-st in the first stitch, tc and turn your work.

Row 3: 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc in the corner, 1 sc in the back loop (=157 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=108 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=157 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=108 sc), end this row with a sl-st in the corner, tc and turn your work.

Row 4: 1 sc in the back loop (=110 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner) 1 sc in the back loop (=159 sc), 1 sc in the back loop (=110 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (= 159 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), end this row with a sl-st, tc and turn your work.

Row 5: 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=161 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=112 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=161 sc), 1 sc-ch 2-1 sc (corner), 1 sc in the back loop (=112 sc), end this row with a sl-st in the first stitch and fo.

weave in the threads and Blanket Sanne is finished
