Cuddly Shawl

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Materials:

- Yarn: 10 balls DROPS Air uni colour
- Crochet hooks: G6(4mm), 7(4,5 mm), H8(5 mm), I9(5,5 mm), J10(6 mm), K10,5(7 mm)
- Needle
- Scissors
- Stitch markers

Abbreviations U.S. terms

ch:	chain
dc:	double crochet
b:	bobble stitch
cl:	cluster
sc:	single crochet
sl.st.:	slip stitch
tc:	turning chain
fp:	front post

Special stitches:

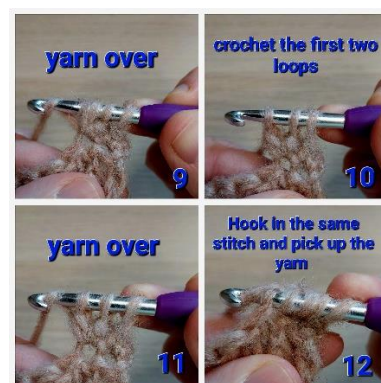
Cluster(c1): yo, put the hook into the stitch from the previous round, pick up the yarn (3 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook through the same stitch and pick up the yarn (4 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (3 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (5 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (4 loops on your hook), crochet the remaining loops in one go, ch 1. (see picture 1,2 3,4,5 and 6)

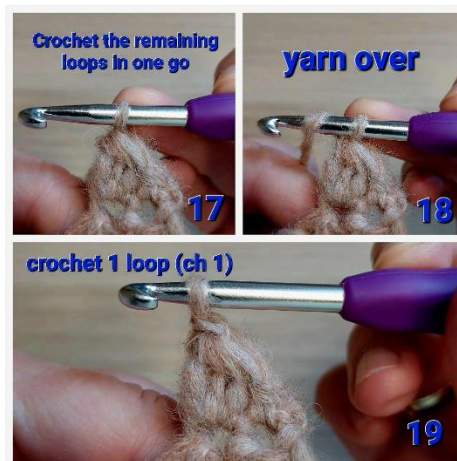

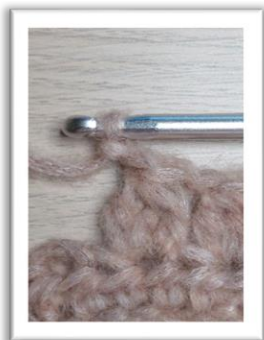

Bobble stitch(b): basically exactly the same as the cluster only you crochet 2 more unfinished double crochets. yo, put the hook into the stitch from the previous round, pick up the yarn (3 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first 2 loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook through the same stitch and pick up the yarn (4 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first 2 loops (3 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (5 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first 2 loops (4 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (6 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first 2 loops (5 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (7 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first 2 loops (6 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining loops in one go, ch 1. (see picture 7)

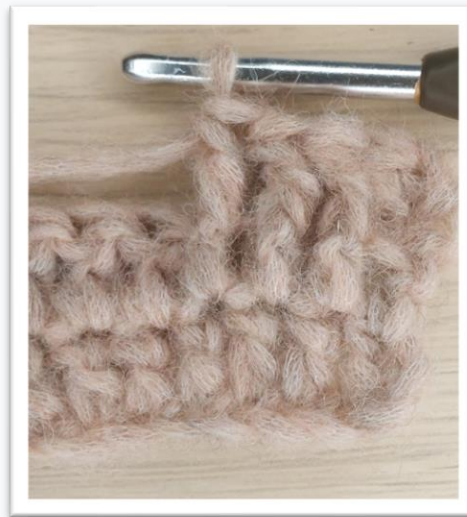

front post(fp): you crochet a double crochet, but not using the regular stitch, you crochet around the post of the stitch **of the stitch**. Yo, insert crochet hook on the right side around the post of the stitch (at the front of your work) and to the left of the stitch your needle reappears. Yo, pull thread through the stitch (3 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first two loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining two loops. (see picture 8 and 9)

back post(bp): same as the fp but you are now working on the backside of your work. Yo, insert crochet hook on the right side around the post of the stitch (**at the backside of your work**) and to the left of the stitch your needle reappears. Yo, pull thread through the stitch (3 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first two loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining two loops. (see picture 10 and 11)

Shawl:

Row 1: (J10, 6 mm crochet hook), ch 74, tc.

Row 2: (H8, 5 mm crochet hook), 73 hdc, tc.

Row 3: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 4: 1 dc, "ch1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc" repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 5: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 6: 1 dc, " ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc" repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 7: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 8: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 9: (i9, 5 mm crochet hook), 1 dc, "ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc in one stitch, ch 1, skip two stitches,

1 dc", repeat what's between "" 11 more times, tc.

Row 10: 2 dc, " ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 3 dc on the double crochet from the previous row " repeat what's between "" 10 more times, ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, skip one stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 11: 1 dc, " ch 1, 3 dc on the double crochet from the previous row (is on the 2nd double crochet from the crochet hook), ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row", repeat what's between "" 11 more times, tc.

Row 12: 2 dc, " ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 3 dc on the double crochet from the previous row", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 2 dc, tc.

Row 13: 1 dc, " ch 1, 3 dc on the double crochet from the previous row (is on the 2nd double crochet from the crochet hook), ch 1, 1 dc in the middle of the 3 double crochets from the previous row", repeat what's between "" 11 more times, tc.

Row 14: (H8, 5 mm crochet hook), 73 hdc, tc.

Row 15: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 16: 1 dc, " ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc", repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 17: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 18: 1 dc, " ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc", repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 19: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 20: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 21: (7, 4,5 mm), 2 dc, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, 3 fp, 2 dc, tc.

Row 22: 2 dc, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, 3 fp, 2 dc, tc.

Row 23: 2 dc, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, 3 fp, 2 dc, tc.

Row 24: 2 dc, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, 3 fp, 2 dc, tc.

Row 25: 2 dc, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, 3 fp, 2 dc, tc.

Row 26: (H8, 5 mm crochet hook), 73 hdc, tc.

Row 27: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 28: 1 dc, " ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc", repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 29: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 30: 1 dc, " ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc", repeat what's between "" 17 more times, tc.

Row 31: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 32: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 33: (K10,5, 7 mm crochet hook) 2 dc in 1 stitch, " ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc in 1 stitch", repeat what's between "" 10 more times, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 2 dc in 1 stitch, tc.

Row 34: 1 dc, “ch 1, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc on the single crochet from the previous row, ch 1, 1 sc on the middle double crochet of the 3 double crochets from the previous row”, repeat what’s between “” 10 more times, ch 1, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc on the single crochet from the previous row, ch 1, 1 dc, tc.

Row 35: 2 dc in 1 stitch, “ch 1, 1 sc in the ch-sp between the 2 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 3 dc on the single crochet from previous row” repeat what’s between “” 10 more times, ch 1, 1 sc in the ch-sp between the 2 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 2 dc, tc.

Row 36: 1 dc, “ch 1, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc on the single crochet from the previous row, ch 1, 1 sc on the middle double crochet of the 3 double crochets from the previous row”, repeat what’s between “” 10 more times, ch 1, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc on the single crochet from the previous row, ch 1, 1 dc, tc.

Row 37: 2 dc in 1 stitch, “ch 1, 1 sc in the ch-sp between the 2 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 3 dc on the single crochet from the previous row” repeat what’s between “” 10 more times, ch 1, 1 sc in the ch-sp between the 2 double crochets from the previous row, ch 1, 2 dc, tc.

Row 38: (H8, 5 mm crochet hook), 73 hdc, tc.

Row 39: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 40: 1 dc, “ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc” repeat what’s between “” 17 more times, tc.

Row 41: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 42: 1 dc, “ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc”, repeat what’s between “” 17 more times, tc.

Row 43: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 44: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 45: (G6, 4 mm crochet hook), 1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, “1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch”, repeat what’s between “” 34 more times, 1 dc, tc.

Row 46: 1 dc, ch 1, “1 cl on the cluster from the previous round, ch 1”, repeat what’s between “” 34 more times, 1 dc, tc.

Row 47: 1 dc, ch 1, “1 cl on the cluster from the previous round, ch 1”, repeat what’s between “” 34 more times, 1 dc, tc.

Row 48: 1 dc, ch 1, “1 cl on the cluster from the previous round, ch 1”, repeat what’s between “” 34 more times, 1 dc, tc.

Row 49: 1 dc, ch 1, “1 cl on the cluster from the previous round, ch 1”, repeat what’s between “” 34 more times, 1 dc, tc.

Row 50: (H8, 5 mm crochet hook), 73 hdc, tc.

Row 51: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 52: 1 dc, “ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc” repeat what’s between “” 17 more times, tc.

Row 53: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 54: 1 dc, “ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 cl, ch 1, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc” repeat what’s between “” 17 more times, tc.

Row 55: 73 hdc, tc

Row 56: 73 hdc, tc.

Row 57: Repeat rows 9 - 56 till you have reached your desired length of your shawl.

(This shawl has become 76,77 inch x 20,47 inch/195 cm x 52 cm)

Crochet all single crochet around the scarf with crochet hook H8/5 mm. (see picture 12 and 13 shawl border) 310 sc in the length, ch 2, 1 sc in the stitch where you just finished (you have crocheted a corner), 72 sc in width (=73 sc), ch 2, 1 sc in the stitch where you just finished, 309 sc (=310 sc), ch 2, 1 sc in the stitch where you just finished, 72 sc in width(=73 sc), ch 2, close the round with a sl.st.

Edge/Border of the shawl (width) with crochet hook, H8/5mm

Row 1: secure the wire in the corner (see picture 14), 1 sc, “ch 7, skip 3 stitches, 2 sc, ch 7, skip 3 stitches, 1 sc”, repeat what’s between “” 7 more times, sl.st., tc.

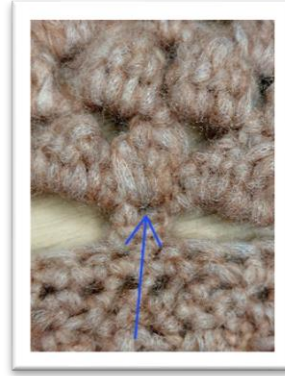
Row 2: 1 sc, 2 sc-1 b-2 sc in every ch-sp, 1 sc, tc (see picture 15 of row 2)

Row 3: 1 sc, ch 2, “1 sc in the bobble stitch from the previous row, ch 2, skip 2 stitches, 1 b in the middle

between the single crochets (**see picture 16**), ch 2", repeat what's between "" 14 more times, 1 sc in the bobble stitch from the previous row, ch 2, 1 sc in last stitch, tc.

Row 4: 1 sc, 1 b in every ch-sp, 1 sc in last stitch, tc. (**see picture 17 of row 4**)

Row 5: ch 3, 1 b between the 1st and 2nd bobble stitch of the previous row (**see picture 18**), ch 3, 1 sc between the 2st and 3rd bobble stitch of the previous row, ch 3, 1 b between the 3rd and 4th bobble stitch of the previous row, ch 3, 1 sc between the 4th and 5th bobble stitch of the previous row, ch 3, etc.... Repeat alternately until end of row, fo. (**see picture 19 of row 5**)
