## special stitches:

To crochet the puff stitch: yo, put the hook under the chain space (of the previous round) and pick up the yarn (3 loops around your hook), repeat this one more time (a total of 5 loops around the hook now), take the yarn and pull it through the loops on the hook, chain one. Now you have crocheted a puff stitch.

Cluster stitch of two double crochet: yo, put the hook into the stitch from the previous round, pick up the yarn (3 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook through the same stitch and pick up the yarn (4 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (3 loops on your hook) crochet the remaining loops and you have a cluster of 2 double crochet.

## You crochet the warm winter scarf in two parts that you join together at the end of your work. You start by crocheting the circles.

## $1^{\text {st }}$ circle, bottom right (crochet hook H-8 ( 5 mm )

Row 1: magic ring with 8 sc , pull the ring tight so that the circle closes nicely. (you continue working in the round)

Row 2: Insert your hook into the first stitch from previous round and crochet 1 sc , ch 1 and 1 dc in the same stitch (this continues for 1 cluster), ch 2," in the next stitch crochet a cluster (how to crochet a cluster, see special stiches Cluster of 2 double crochets), ch 2" Repeat 6 more times what's stands between "", close the round with a sl st.

Row 3: Crochet a sc in the chain space from the previous round, crochet puff in the same chain, ch 1, puff (in the same chain), in the next 7 chain spaces repeat puff, ch 1, puff ,(so in every chain space from the previous round crochet 2 puff stiches), close the round with a sl st.

(picture row 3 )

Row 4: 1 sc in the chain space of the previous round (it is the chain space of 2 chains between the clusters), ch 2 (continues for 1 dc ) now crochet 6 more dc (total 7 dc in that chain space).

Now crochet 7 dc in each chain space, a total of 8 bows of 7 double crochet at the end of this round, close the round with a sl st.

Row 5: ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round (it is the middle of the seven double crochet bow from previous round), ch 4, 1 sc (between de two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round).

Now we are going to crochet the corners, ch 5, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 5,1 dc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 5,1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4 , close the round with a sl st.

(circle bottom right)

## $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle, bottom center

Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle, bottom right.
Row 5: ch 5,1 dc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round (it is the middle of the seven double crochet bow from previous round),ch 5,1 sc (between de two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round), ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ between the two bows, ch 5, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, (Now we are going to crochet this circle to the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle, bottom right) ch 2 , you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain space of the corner from the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle, bottom right, and take the loop you just took your crochet hook from (the loop of the circle you are working on) and pull the loop under this chain space (see picture 2),ch 3, 1 sc between the two bows, ch 2 , you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 4 chains from the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right and you take the loop of the work you are working on and pull the loop under this chain space (you basically repeat what you just did on the corner) (see picture 3) ch 2, 1 sc on 4th double crochet, ch 2, you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain space of 4 chains from $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right and you take the loop of the work you are working on and pull the loop under this chain space (see picture 4) ch 2,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4 , close round with a sl st.

## $3^{\text {rd }}$ circle bottom left.

Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right.
Row 5: ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round, ch 4,1 sc between de two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (Now we are going to crochet a corner) ch $5,1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet another corner) ch 5, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 5, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, (Now we are going to crochet this circle to the $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle bottom center) ch 2 , you take the hook out of the loop and go with
your crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain space of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle bottom center and take the loop you just took your crochet hook from and pull the loop under this chain space (see picture 5), ch 3,1 sc between the two bows, ch 2 you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of the 4 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle bottom center and you take the loop from the work you are working on and pull the loop under this chain space (crochet hook stays in the loop), you basically repeat what you just did on the corner (see picture 3), ch 2 , 1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2 , you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain space of 4 chain of the the $2^{\text {nd }}$ circle bottom center and you take the loop from the work you are working on and pull the loop under this chain space the hook stays in the loop ( see picture 4), ch 2, close the round with a sl st between the two bows.

(the 3 bottom circles)

## $4^{\text {th }}$ circle top right

Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right.
Row 5: ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round, (Now we are going to crochet a corner), ch 5,1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet another corner) ch 5,1 dc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5 , 1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4 , 1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet the circle to the circle bottom right) ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom right and pick up the loop again (see picture 6), ch 2,

1 sc on $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2, (take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook, under the next chain space of 4 chains and pick up the loop again (see picture 7 ), ch 2, 1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet another corner and crochet it to the circle bottom right), ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 5 chains from the circle bottom right and pick up the loop again (see picture 8), ch 3, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5 , close round with a sl st.

## $5^{\text {th }}$ circle top center

Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right.
Row 5: ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round, (Now we are going to crochet a corner) ch 5,1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet the circle at the circle bottom center), ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom center and pick up the loop again like you did before but now with circle bottom center, see picture 6) ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2 (take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook, under the next chain space of 4 chains and pick up the loop again exactly as you did before see picture 9) ch 2,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet the circle at the circle top right), ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of the 4 chains from the circle top right and pick up the loop again, see picture 10) ch 2,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2 (take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook, under the next chain space of 4 chains and pick up the loop again see picture 11), ch 2,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet the corners of the circle top right and the corner from the circle top center together), ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 5 chains from the circle top right and pick up the loop see picture 12) ch $3,1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5 close the round with a sl st.

## $6{ }^{\text {th }}$ circle top left

## Row 1 to row 4 the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ circle bottom right.

Row 5: ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet of the previous round, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows of seven double crochets from the previous round, (Now we are going to crochet a corner) ch 5,1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5,1 sc between the two bows, ch $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$, on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (now we are going to crochet another corner and we crochet the circle top left to the circle bottom left), ch 5, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 5 chains from the circle bottom left and pick up the loop see picture 13) ch 3,1 sc between the two bows, ch 2 , (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom left and pick up the loop, like: see picture 6) ch 2,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2 (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains an pick up the loop, like: see picture 7 ), ch 2,1 sc between the two bows, ch 4,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 4,1 sc between the two bows, (we are now going to crochet the circle top left to the circle top center) ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 4 chains from the circle top center and pick up the loop, like: see picture 10)ch 2,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 2 , (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle top center and pick up the loop, like: see picture 11)ch 2, 1 sc between the two bows,(now we are going to crochet the corner from the circle top left corner to the corner of the circle top center) ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of 5 chains from the circle top center and pick up the loop, like: see picture 12), ch 3, 1 dc on the $4^{\text {th }}$ double crochet, ch 5 , close the round with a sl st.

## 2 small circles

## $1^{\text {st }}$ small circle:

Row 1: magic ring with 8 sc , pull the ring tight so that the circle closes nicely. (you continue working in the round)

Row 2: Insert your hook into the first stitch from previous round and crochet $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ and 1 dc in the same stitch (this continues for 1 cluster), ch 2," in the next stitch work a cluster,
ch 2" Repeat 6 more times what's stands between "", close the round with a sl st.
Row 3: (we are now going to crochet the small circles between the large circles). 1 sc in the first chain space of the previous round, ch 2 , you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the chain space of the circle top center and pick up the loop again, see picture 14), ch 2,1 sc in the next chain space of the small circle (see picture 15), ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of the circle top center and pick up the loop again) ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle top left see picture 16) ch $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle top left) ch 2,1 sc in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom left, see picture 17), ch 2,1 sc in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2 , (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom left), ch 2, 1 sc in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2, (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom center see picture 18)
ch 2,1 sc in the next chain space of the small circle, ch 2 , (you take the hook out of the loop and go with your crochet hook under the next chain space of 4 chains from the circle bottom center), ch 2, close the round with a sl st in the small circle where you started with a sc. $2^{\text {nd }}$ small circle for the right side: repeat row 1 to row 3


## Border around the circles:

We start in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain space of 5 chains in the top right corner with 1 sc (see picture 19), ch 2 (this continues for 1 dc ), 4 dc in that same chain space, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet 5 dc (see picture 20), ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next chain space, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space, ch 3, 5 dc , in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet 5 dc (see picture 20) (just like you did before), ch 3, 1 sc in the next chain space, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space, ch 3, (now we are at the left corner) 5 dc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next chain of 5 chains (now you have crochet the left corner see picture 21), ch 3,1 sc in the next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet $5 \mathrm{dc}($ like: see picture 20 ) ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in next chain space, ch 3 , (now we are at the lower left corner) 5 dc in the next chain spaces, ch 3, 5 dc in next chain space (just like you did it in the left corner), ch 3, 1 sc in next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet 5 dc (see picture 20), ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space, ch 3 , 1 sc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$, in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet 5 dc (see picture 20), ch $3,1 \mathrm{cs}$ in next chain space, ch $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next chain space, ch 3 , (we are at the lower right corner) 5 dc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next chain space (just like: see picture 21), ch 3,1 sc in the next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in the next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next chain space, the part where you crochet the circles together in the previous round you skip and you take the next chain of 5 chains and crochet 5 dc (see picture 20), ch 3,1 sc in next chain space, ch 3,1 sc in next chain space, ch $3,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in next chain space, ch 3, close round with a sl st. Do not cut the wire!!!

Now we are going to crochet a single crochet in each stitch. Attention!! In the chain spaces of 3 chain from the previous round we crochet 2 sc (this is to make sure that the work stays straight). And in the chain space of 3 chains at the corners we crochet $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{sc}$.

We start right above on the 5 double crochets, there you crochet 5 sc (see picture 22), 2 sc in the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain space from previous round, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp from previous round, 2 sc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp from the previous round, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet from the previous round, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2$ sc in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 5 double crochet, (We are now at the top left corner) $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{sc}$, in the ch-sp of the corner, mark the corner with a stitch marker (see picture 23), 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, 2 sc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, (we are now at the next corner) $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{sc}$, in the ch-sp of the corner, mark the corner with a stitch marker (see picture 23), 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chsp, 2 sc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp, 2 sc in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}$, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, (we are at the $3^{\text {rd }}$ corner) $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the ch-sp of the corner, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, 5 sc on the next 5 double crochet, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}-\mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3^{\text {rd }} \mathrm{ch}$-sp, 5 sc on the 5 double crochet, (last corner) 2 sc , ch 1 , 2 sc , close the round with a sl st and fasten off

We now continue and crochet further with crochet hook k-10-5 ( 7 mm ) and start with color graphite (grey). (I chose crochet hook K-10-5 (7 mm) because, with a smaller crochet hook the work becomes a little bit stiff). Because we continue to crochet with a larger crochet hook we decrease to 47 stiches. ATTENTION!!! After each row a turning chain.
Row 1: 1 sc in the upper right corner (see picture 24), $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 14 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, 14 \mathrm{sc}$, dec, 3 sc (=47 sc), tc, turn.

Row 2: 47 sc (in the last stich change color, see picture),tc. Attention do not cut the wire!!! turn.


Row 3: $7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}$ (see picture 25), $7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp} 7 \mathrm{sc}$, tc, turn.
Row 4: 47 sc , change color, tc, turn.
Row 5: $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{tc}$, turn.
Row 6: 47 sc , change color, tc, turn.
Row 7: $3 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{tc}$, turn.
Row 8: 47 sc , change color, tc, turn.
Row 9: $5 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 7 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{fp}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{tc}$, turn.
Row 10: 47 sc , change color, tc, turn.
Repeat Row 3 to 10 to desired length. ( 41 inch ( 104 cm )

(picture up to row 10)

When you have crocheted both parts, crochet them together with sc (zie picture both parts together). Do not cut the wire!!!

(both parts together)
now you are going to crochet sc around de scarf. (so you start crocheting in the middle of the scarf, on the side) make sure you have the same amount of sc on both sides of the scarf. In the first part of the scarf (the part of the circles) you can crochet a single crochet in each stitch with the same crochet hook where you crocheted the circles with. in this case that number is the $\mathrm{H}-8$ ( 5 mm ) crochet hook.

In the ch-sp of the corners you crochet $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same ch-sp.
(So the part with the front post, you use crochet hook nr K10-5 (7 mm)for crocheting the single crochets and the part with the circles you use crochet hook H-8 ( 5 mm ) for crocheting the single crochets) when you're all the way around end the row with a slip stich, fo.

The border: crochet hook 5 mm
attention!! Wrong side towards you, we have 53 stitches including the corners.
when crocheting the borders I chose the color light green (Meadow) for the dark green side and the dark green (Khaki) for the light green side

Row 1: $53 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{tc}$, turn.
Row 2: 1 sl st, " $1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{trc}, 1 \mathrm{dtr}, 1 \mathrm{trc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ " repeat what's between "" 4 more times, 2 sl st , tc, turn.
Row 3: 1 sl st , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the single crochet from previous round (so you skip 1 stitch), ch 2, 1 dc on the half double crochet from previous round (so you skip 2 stitches), ch 1, $1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{ch} 1-1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the double treble crochet from the previous round (so all 3 in the same stitch), ch 1,1 dc, ch 2, skip 2 stitches, 3 hdc,"ch 2, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1,1 dc-ch $1-1$ dc on the double treble crochet from the previous round, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, 3 hdc" repeat what's between "" 2 more times,
ch 2, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc-ch 1-1 dc on the double treble crochet from the previous round, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2 , skip 2 stitches, 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, \mathrm{tc}$, turn.

Row 4: attention!! in this row you skip the stiches on the double crochets and only work on the chain-spaces, except on the 3 half double crochet you crochet 2 single crochets between the stiches (see picture 26)

1 sc in the ch-sp of the chain 1 from the previous round, " 2 sc in the ch-sp, 2 sc in next ch-sp, 1 sc-ch 4-1 sc in next ch-sp (on the top), 2 sc in next ch-sp, 2 sc in next ch-sp, 2 sc between the 3 half double crochets", repeat what's between "" 3 times, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 2 sc In the next ch-sp, 1 sc-ch $4-1$ sc in next ch-sp (on the top), 2 sc In the ch-sp, 2 sc in the next ch-sp, 1 sc in the last ch-sp close the row with a sl st in the last stich from the precious round, fo.
