# AK haakwerkjes Cuddly Hat

•Yarn:

2 balls DROPS Air uni colour oks: G6(4mm), 7(4,5 mm), H8(5 mm), i9(5,5 mm), K10,5(7 mm)

- •Crochet hooks: •Needle
- •Scissors
- Stitch markers

### **Special stitches:**

**Cluster(cl):** yo, put the hook into the stitch from the previous round, pick up the yarn (3 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook through the same stitch and pick up the yarn (4 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (3 loops on your hook), yo, put your hook into the same stitch and pick up the yarn (5 loops on your hook), crochet the first 2 loops (4 loops on your hook), crochet the remaining loops in one go, ch 1. (see picture 1,2 3,4,5 and 6)

front post(fp): you crochet a double crochet, but not using the regular stitch, you crochet around the post of the stitch. Yo, insert crochet hook on the right side around the post of the stitch (at the front of your work) and to the left of the stitch your needle reappears. Yo, pull thread through the stitch (3 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first two loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining two loops. (see picture 8 and 9)

**back post(bp): same as the fp but you are now working on the backside of your work.** Yo, insert crochet hook on the right side around the post of the stitch **(at the backside of your work)** and to the left of the stitch your needle reappears. Yo, pull thread through the stitch (3 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the first two loops (2 loops on your hook), yo, crochet the remaining two loops. **(see picture 10 and 11)**

### We start at the top of the hat and crochet in the round. Use a stitch marker in the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch so you know where your row starts and ends.

Row 1: (H8/5mm) magic ring with 6 sc.

Row 2: 2 sc in each stitch = 12 sc

**Row 3:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $2^{nd}$  stitch = 18 sc **Row 4:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $3^{rd}$  stitch = 24 sc **Row 5:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $4^{th}$  stitch = 30 sc **Row 6:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $5^{th}$  stitch = 36 sc **Row 7:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $6^{th}$  stitch = 42 sc **Row 8:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $7^{th}$  stitch = 48 sc **Row 9:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $8^{th}$  stitch = 54 sc **Row 10:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $9^{th}$  stitch = 60 sc **Row 11:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $10^{th}$  stitch = 66 sc **Row 12:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $10^{th}$  stitch = 72 sc **Row 13:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $12^{th}$  stitch = 78 sc **Row 14:** one sc in each stitch and 2 sc in every  $13^{th}$  stitch = 84 sc

Row 15: (G6/4 mm) "ch 1, 1 cl", repeat what is between "41 times, ch 1, close the round with a sl st.

**Row 16: (K10,5/7 mm)** ch 1, 3 dc on the 1<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc (in the space between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> cluster), ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 4<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc (in the space between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> cluster), ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 7<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 10<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 13<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 13<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 19<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 25<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 28<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 sc, ch

**Row 17:** ch 1, "1 sc on the middle double crochet of the 3 double crochets from the previous round, ch 1, 1dc-ch1-1dc on the single crochet of the previous round, ch 1" repeat what is between "" 13 times, close the round with a sl st.

Row 18: (H8/5mm) 1 hdc in each stitch, close the round with a sl st (=84 hdc)

Row 19: (7/4,5 mm) ch 1, "3 fp, 3 bp", repeat what is between "" 13 times, close the round with a sl st.

Row 20: ch 1, "3 bp, 3 fp", repeat what is between "" 13 times, close the round with a sl st. Row 21: (G6/4 mm) "ch 1, 1 cl", repeat what is between "" 41 times, ch 1, close the round with a sl st. **Row 22: (H8/5,5 mm)** ch 1, 3 dc on the 1<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc (in the space between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> cluster), ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 4<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc (in the space between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> cluster), ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 7<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 10<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 13<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 16<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 13<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 16<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 19<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 25<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 28<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 31<sup>st</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc on the 40<sup>th</sup> cluster, ch 1, skip 2 stitches, 1 dc, ch

**Row 23:** ch 1, "1 dc on the middle double crochet of the 3 double crochets from the previous round, ch 1, 3 dc on the double crochet from the previous round, ch 1", repeat what is between "" 13 times, close the round with a sl st.

Row 24: (H8/5 mm) 1 hdc in each stitch, close the round with a sl st (=84 hdc)

#### Do not cut wire!!! We continue with the board.

### **Board:**

Row 1: ch 25 (see picture 1), tc, 25 sc (see picture 2), 1 sc in the edge to close the row (see picture 3).

**Row 2:** 1 sc in the edge to to start this row, turn your work, skip 2 stitches, 24 sc in the back loop, 1 sc (normal stitch), tc.

**Row 3:** 1 sc, 24 sc in the back loop, 1 sc in the edge to close the row.

Repeat row 2 and 3 all the way around the hat (see picture 4)

Crochet both parts of the border together with single crochet (see picture 5). fo, weave away the threads, your hat is finished.
