Materials:

Crochet hooks: E-4 (3,5 mm) crochet hook

Yarn: 1 ball of stylecraft Special double knit 1823 Mustard

1 ball of stylecraft Special double knit 1005 Cream

Needle: to get rid of your threads at the end

Scissors: to cut threads

Stitch markers

Abbreviations U.S. terms

st: stich

ch: chain

sc: single crochet

fp: front post

tc: turning chain

ch-sp: chain space

fo: fasten off

We start at the top of the hat and crochet in the round, using a stitchmarker in the 1st stitch so you know where your round begins and ends.

Row 1: with the color mustard Magic ring with 6 sc

Row 2: 2 sc in each st = 12 sc

Row 3: 2 sc in every 2nd st = 18 sc

Row 4: 2 sc in every 3rd st = 24 sc

Row 5: 2 sc in every 4th st = 30 sc

Row 6: 2 sc in every 5th st = 36 sc

Row 7: 2 sc in every 6th st = 42 sc

Row 8: 2 sc in every 7th st = 48 sc

Row 9: 2 sc in every 8th st = 54 sc

Row 10: 2 sc in every 9th st = 60 sc

Row 11: 2 sc in every 10th st = 66 sc

Row 12: 2 sc in every 11th st = 72 sc

Row 13: 2 sc in every 12th st = 78 sc

Row 14: 2 sc in every 13th st = 84 sc

Row 15: 2 sc in every 14th st = 90 sc

Row 16: 2 sc in every 15th st = 96 sc

Row 17: 2 sc in every 16th st = 102 sc

Row 18: 2 sc in the 1st st, 50 sc, 2 sc in the 51st st, 50 sc = 104 sc **(In the last stitch we turn on the color cream, zie picture 1)**

Attention do not cut the wire.

Row 19: 104 sc with cream. **(In the last stitch we turn on the color mustard, just like picture 1)**

Row 20: continue with the color mustard, 104 sc. **(In the last stitch we turn on the color cream, just like picture 1)**

from here we continue crocheting in mosaic. The method of back and forward crocheting. So from now on we don't work around anymore.

Row 21: "1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 4 sc, ch 2, skip 1 stitch, 4 sc, ch 2, skip 1 stitch, 1 sc", repeat what's between "" 8 more times, tc.

Row 22: the way back you work exactly the stitches from row 21, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet and above every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row (**see picture 2**), turn on color mustard (**see picture 3**), tc.

Row 23: "1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 2 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 2 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc", repeat what's between "" 8 more times, tc.

Row 24: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color cream, tc.

Row 25: "1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc", repeat what's between "" 8 more times, tc.

Row 26: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color mustard, tc.

Row 27: " 1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc" repeat what's between "" 8 more times, tc.

Row 28: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color cream, tc.

Row 29: “2 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 2 sc,” repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 30: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color mustard, tc.

row 31: “ 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc,”repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 32: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color cream, tc.

Row 33: “1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc ”, repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 34: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color mustard, tc.

Row 35: “2 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 2 sc”, repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 36: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color cream, tc.

Row 37: “1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc ”,repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 38: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color mustard, tc.

Row 39: “1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 fp, 1 sc, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 sc, 1 fp, 1 sc ”, repeat what’s between “” 8 more times, tc.

Row 40: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet**, every chain 2 a chain 2 till the end of the row, turn on color

cream, tc.

Row 41: "3 sc, 1 fp, 2 sc, 1 fp, 2 sc, 1 fp, 3 sc", repeat what's between "" 8 more times, tc.

Row 42: the way back you work almost the stitches from the row before, like this: a single crochet on every single crochet **and above every front post a single crochet (a row with only sc)**, at the end of this row you have 104 sc, turn on color mustard in the last stitch just like in picture 3.

Row 43: 104 sc

from now on you will work in the round again use a stitch marker in the first stitch so you know where your round starts and ends.

Row 44: You crochet 1 stitch through with the color mustard but you don't complete the stitch , take the color cream and pull it through the 2 loops **see picture 4**, and place the stitch marker in the 1st color cream stitch (**see picture 4**), 104 sc in the color cream.

Row 45: in the 1st st turn on color mustard, ch 30 (**see picture 5**)

Row 46: 30 sc, 1 sc in the cream edge to close the row (**see picture 6**)

Row 47: 1 sc in the cream edge of the hat to start this row (**see picture 7**), skip 2 stitches, 30 sc in the back loop of each stitch, tc.

Row 48: 30 sc in back loop of each stitch, 1 sc in the cream edge to close the row

Row 49: 1 sc in the cream edge to start this row, skip 2 stitches, 30 sc in back loop of each stitch, tc.

Row 50: repeat rows 48 and 49 until you have completed the row, **see picture 8**

We crochet both parts of the brim together with sc, see picture 9a en 9b, fo and and leave a long thread. With the end of that thread we close the opening, with the mattress stitch.

If you don't know what a mattress stitch is, in my tutorial of Hat Friends on YouTube I show you how the mattress stitch is done.

And when you have done all that your hat is ready to be worn.
